RICHMOND, Ind. – Daniel H. “Grandpa Floore” Charping, age 83, of Richmond, Indiana, died Friday, June 2, 2017, at Reid Health.

Born January 26, 1934, in Greenville, South Carolina, to Robert and Silda Blue Charping, Daniel had lived in this community since 1990. 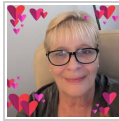
“ *For My Grandpa*
