RICHMOND, Ind. – Harold E. Clements, age 86, of Richmond, died Monday, June 25, 2012, at Golden Living Center/Golden Rule. Born May 19, 1926, in New Garden Township (Fountain City), he was a life-long resident of this area. Harold was a 1945 graduate of Lynn High School and W.W. II Army veteran, serving from 1944 to 1947. He was a block operator for Conrail Railroad, retiring in 1984 after 35 years.
