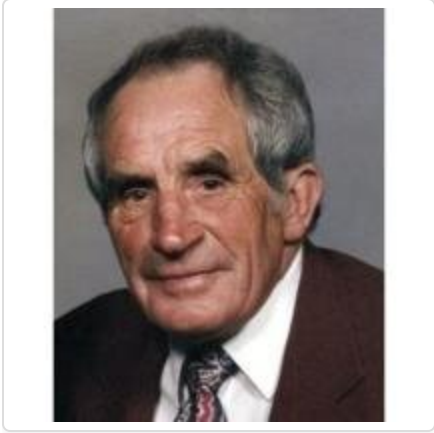




Jack E. Isaacs

September 6, 1929 - April 8, 2009

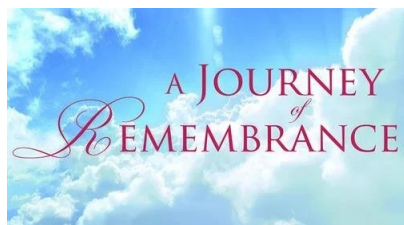
