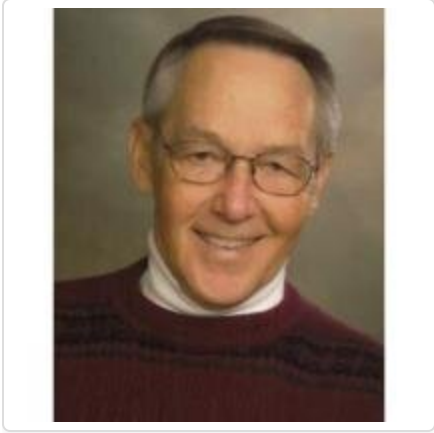




Lynn E. Paddock

October 4, 1937 - May 14, 2011

RICHMOND, Ind. – Lynn E. Paddock, age 73, of Richmond, died unexpectedly Saturday, May 14, 2011, at Methodist Hospital. Born October 4, 1937, in Hamilton, Ohio, to Franklin and Pauline Black Paddock, he lived in Richmond since 1959. Lynn was a 1955 graduate of College Corner (Ohio) High School and served in the U.S. Air Force from 1956–1959. He worked for over 40 years with Wallace Metal Products in Richmond and retired after 20 years as Plant Manager in Anniston, Alabama. Lynn was a member of Fountain City Wesleyan Church. He was a very active volunteer with Meals on Wheels and Reid Hospital. Lynn enjoyed spending time with his family and grandchildren, the Shawnee Valley Dulcimer Society in Brookville, gardening, and skiing. Survivors include his wife of 52 years, Mary Frances Stelle Paddock; daughter, Amy Paddock of Liberty; two sons, Gregory L. Paddock of Indianapolis and Michael F. (Jenny) Paddock of Richmond; grandchildren, Johnathon (Katie) Paddock of St. Louis, Missouri, Brandon (Jessica) Paddock of Evansville, and Matthew Paddock of Richmond; great-granddaughter, Kara Paddock of Evansville; brother, Allen (Tonya) Paddock of West College Corner, Indiana; cousins; and many friends. He was preceded in death by his parents. Public graveside for Lynn E. Paddock will be at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, May 17, 2011 at College Corner Cemetery (south of College Corner United Methodist Church) in West College Corner, Indiana, with Pastor Keith Vincent officiating and military honors by the Wayne County Honor Guard.
