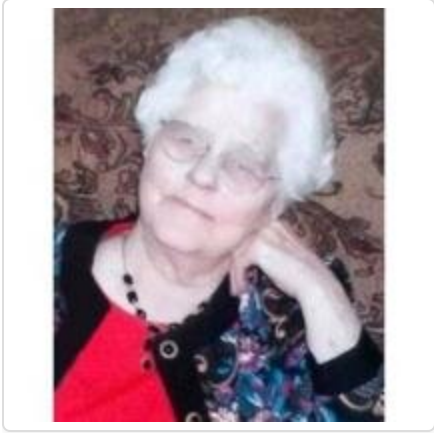




Madeline E. Abrams
