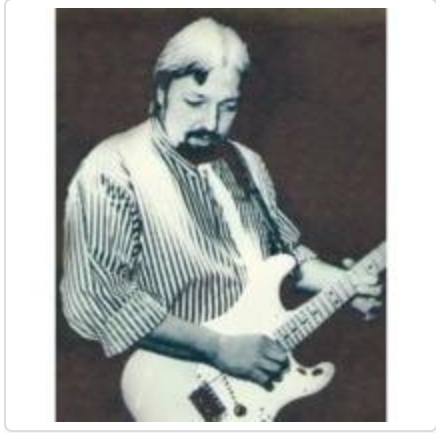




Michael J. Null
