



Mildred Heinz Stewart

April 5, 1915 - February 27, 2017

RICHMOND, Ind. – Mildred Heinz Stewart, age 101, of Richmond, Indiana, passed away on Monday, February 27, 2017, just weeks before her 102nd birthday.

Born April 5, 1915, in Jamestown, Ohio, to Jacob and Blanche (Huffman) Heinz, Mildred had also resided in Columbus, Ohio, and Yardley, Pennsylvania. She and her beloved late husband, Wendell, came to live in Richmond 63 years ago. During those years, Mildred had been an active member and supporter of Reid Memorial Presbyterian Church, and was also a member of the Woman's Club. She was a valued member of the Petal and Stem Garden Club in Richmond for six decades where she served as President many times through the years. The Garden Clubs of Indiana had recently named an academic scholarship in Mildred's honor. Gardening was a true passion for her, winning multitudes of prizes for her flower arranging and plant specimens. In 1985, Mildred was bestowed the Honeywell Horticulture Award sponsored by Purdue University for excellence in the advancement of horticulture.

Mildred will also be well remembered as a gourmet home cook by those fortunate to have sampled her culinary talents. She and Wendell traveled extensively throughout the world, visiting nearly every state in the U.S., Canada, Mexico, Central and South America, Europe, Scandinavia, Asia, the

Near East, and Australia.

I always thought to myself, I want to be like her when I grow up.

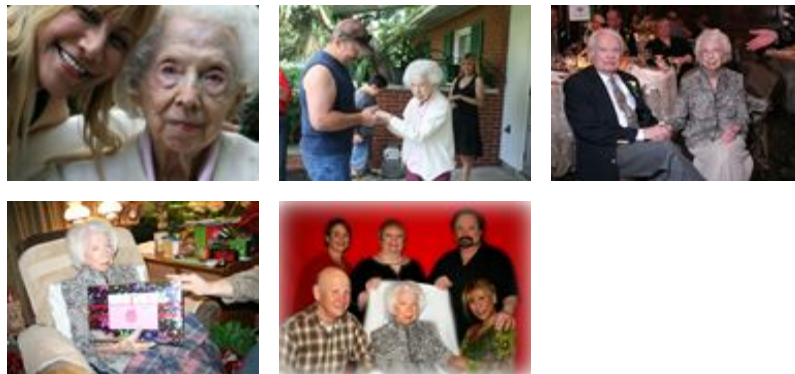
