October 6, 1939 - March 29, 2013

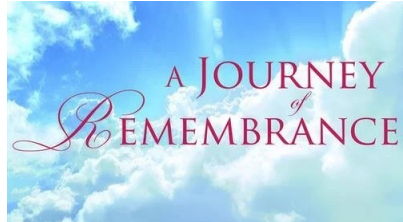
