RICHMOND, Ind. – Patsy Ruth Schultz, age 74, of Richmond, was called home to Heaven surrounded by her family at her bedside on Thursday, November 15, 2007, at Golden Rule Living Center. Born December 28, 1932, in Piqua, Ohio, to John E. and Alberta B. Smith Butts, she was a resident of Richmond since 1967. Pat graduated from Piqua High School in 1950. She married Gene P. Schultz of Troy, Ohio on March 31, 1956 at the First Christian Church in Piqua, Ohio. They resided in Troy, Ohio and Littleton, Colorado prior to moving to Richmond in 1967. Pat retired from Belden Wire and Cable in December of 1992, after eleven years as a secretary. She previously worked for Manpower where she worked for 43 different companies in the Richmond area in various endeavors. She was an avid artist and painter and played the English hand bells at First English Lutheran Church.
