RICHMOND, Ind. – Paul E. Allen, age 65, of Richmond, died Monday, September 29, 2014, at Reid Hospital. Born July 3, 1949, in Batesville, Indiana, to Chester F. and Mildred M. Lanning Allen, Paul grew up in Connersville and was a graduate of Connersville High School. He lived most of his adult life in Richmond. Paul had been the Senior Vice President and Security Officer of First Bank Richmond, where he had worked for 37 years. He owned Allen Real Estate Appraisals and taught drum lessons at the Music Pantry in Richmond.
