CENTERVILLE, Ind. - Robert M. Cramer, age 69, of Centerville, died Thursday, June 13, 2013, at his home after a lengthy illness. Born September 6, 1943, in Dayton, Ohio, to Clarence James and Anna Marie Feller Cramer, he lived in Centerville, Indiana, since 1994.
