



Ruth A. Eudaley

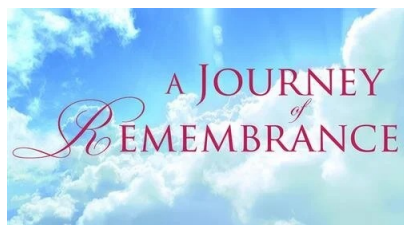
April 25, 1929 - January 26, 2010

FORT WAYNE, Ind. – Ruth A. Eudaley, age 70, of Richmond, formerly of Fort Wayne, Ind., died Tuesday, January 26, 2010, at Heritage House of Richmond. Born April 25, 1929, in Lewisville, Ind., to James and Kathryn M. Brumfiel Eudaley, she lived most of her life in Fort Wayne.
