June 28, 1926 - November 17, 2012

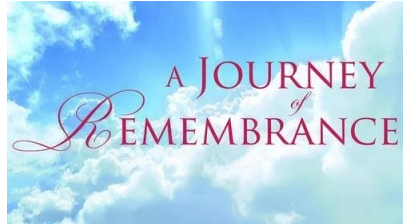
